Steam in '74. For the rail-fan vacationer two publications are indespensible. The Steam Passenger Service Directory (including Electric Lines and Museums) and Steam '74. The Directory is in its 9th edition for 1974 and is an illustrated listing of tourist railroad, tolley and museum operations with regularly scheduled or intermittent passenger service. The 1973 edition contained over 115 entries located in Canada and the United States. Not all steam train operations and museums with railroad exhibits appear in the directory because many organizations failed to respond to requests for information. This excellent publication is available for \$2 from the Empire State Railway Museum, P.O. Box 666, Middletown, New York 10949, or it may be purchased locally at the Whistle Stop, 3819 6th Ave., San Diego, California 92103.

Steam '74 is of value to the traveler to the British Isles. It is a complete enthusiast's handbook to railway preservation activities in the British Isles and contains over 400 entries. This publication is a large format book divided into regions with a map of the region pinpointint the locations of each entry. Photos and details of operations, artifacts, prices and open days make this a very interesting book even if you do not plan to travel overseas. It is priced at 90p (\$2.15) and can be ordered from Mr. T.G. Kirtland, 31 Old Croft Road, Walton-on-the-Hill, Strafford, England. Availability in U.S. stores is unknown.
