It also proposed to discontinue Saturday service on the following routes: F and K. Route extensions are proposed on Rte E to include Fletcher Hills. Portions of Rtes 12 and 7 are proposed to be combined into a new route 12 to serve the Lincoln Acres-Paradise Hills area.
