FT. WORTH AND DENVER:

Notices were posted on April 1, the day after losing the mail contact, that the the remaining Dallas-Denver passenger trains, numbers 2 and 7, would be discontinued on May 10. Opposition to the trains discontinuance was voiced and with the hearings involved the trains will continue until around September. (The Clearance Card)

THE SANTA FE'S TEXAS CHIEF was discontinued between Houston and Galveston on April 10 and 11.....New upcoming passenger power is expected to be a cross between a "geep" and a "covered wagon."
